Incomplete documentation may result in the rejection of your application.

<input type="checkbox"/>	Passport size picture , not older than six months with a bright background and frontal view of the face (please do not attach the picture to the application form) Digitally-altered passport pictures will not be accepted
<input type="checkbox"/>	Registration letter from a language school in Germany
<input type="checkbox"/>	CV
<input type="checkbox"/>	Motivation letter
<input type="checkbox"/>	Proof of sufficient funds to cover the costs of your stay (the equivalent of 861.00 EUR per month): blocked account (for further information see website)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Proof of housing in Germany with full address (e.g. rental contract, hotel reservation) OR invitation letter in case of private accommodation with name, full address and their passport copy
<input type="checkbox"/>	Valid passport (issued within the last 10 years and valid for at least 6 months after arriving in Germany with at least two empty pages)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Irish residence permit card
<input type="checkbox"/>	Self-addressed envelope (An Post only), 9,20,- Euros stamp <i>Or Envelope and stamps can be purchased for 10 Euros at the Embassy</i>
<input type="checkbox"/>	Visa fee 75,- Euros
	After approval: Travel insurance covering you until the start date of your studies (must include cover for COVID 19)
