	1) Copy of the letter of conditional acceptance from a German university, OR
	2) Derived Proof of qualification to be accepted at a German university
	Letter of motivation providing information on the planned course of action to find a
	university place (sector, region, intended place of residence/ accommodation etc.)
	Proof of sufficient funds to cover the costs of your stay (the equivalent of 861.00 EUR per
	month, 1 year: 10,332.00 EUR): blocked account (for further information see website)
	Proof of housing in Germany with full address (e.g. rental contract, hotel reservation) OR
	invitation letter in case of private accommodation with name, full address and their
	passport copy
	Self-addressed envelope (An Post only), 9,20,- Euros stamp <i>Or</i> Envelope and stamps can be purchased for 10 Euros at the Embassy
	Visa fee 75,- Euros
	Valid passport (issued within the last 10 years and valid for at least 6 months after arriving in Germany with at least two empty pages)
	Irish residence permit card
	After approval: Travel insurance covering you until the start date of your studies
