Please prepare **two identical application sets (2 sets of copies)** with all of the following documents in the given order. Please bring your original certificates as well as your original Au-Pair contract along. Please DO NOT staple any documents.

Incomplete documentation may result in the rejection of your application.

<input type="checkbox"/>	Application form fully completed including declaration Section 54 (2) 8, duly signed
<input type="checkbox"/>	Passport size picture , not older than six months with a bright background and frontal view of the face (please do not attach the picture to the application form) Digitally-altered passport pictures will not be accepted.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Au Pair contract with an Au Pair agency or family in Germany stating the full address (including postal code) of your Au Pair family
<input type="checkbox"/>	Proof of German language skills , at least level A1
<input type="checkbox"/>	CV
<input type="checkbox"/>	Motivation letter
<input type="checkbox"/>	Valid passport (issued within the last 10 years and valid for at least 6 months after arriving in Germany with at least two empty pages)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Irish residence permit
<input type="checkbox"/>	Self-addressed envelope (An Post only), 9,20,- Euros stamp <i>Or</i> Envelope and stamps can be purchased for 10 Euros at the Embassy
<input type="checkbox"/>	Visa fee 75,- Euros
	After approval: Health insurance covering you for the duration of your Au Pair contract
