Incomplete documentation may result in the rejection of your application.

	Passport size picture, not older than six months with a bright background and
	frontal view of the face (please do not attach the picture to the application form)
	Digitally-altered passport pictures will not be accepted
	CV on occupational career with certificates and diplomas
	Motivation letter with information about the intended job search (branch, region,
	accommodation)
	Recognised university degree, original and copy, AND if applicable: official
	translation into German or English
	Anabin database printout - you can find out if your foreign degree compares to
	German qualifications through the online database "Anabin" www.anabin.kmk.org
	(in German).
	Proof that you are able to support yourself while staying in Germany (bank
	statements, payslips of the last three months or declaration of support / letter of
	guarantee - "Verpflichtungserklärung")
	Self-addressed envelope (An Post only), 9,20,- Euros stamp
	Or Envelope and stamps can be purchased for 10 Euros at the Embassy
	Valid passport (issued within the last 10 years and valid for at least 6 months after
	arriving in Germany with at least two empty pages)
	Irish residence permit card
	Visa fee 75,- Euros
	After approval: Travel insurance covering you for the duration of your visa
