

Working Holiday Programme

<u>VIDEX application form</u> fully completed including declaration Section 54 (2) 8, duly signed and printed (including barcodes)
1 fully biometric passport photo (35x45mm) , not older than six months with a bright background and frontal view of the face. Digitally altered passport pictures will not be accepted.
Detailed CV (up to date, in German or English including the city, province or territory of the employer or educational institution)
Personal motivation letter in German or English explaining in detail what motivates you to take part in a working holiday program and what you expect to achieve through this programme
Flight itinerary (intended or booked flights)
Proof of sufficient financial means, to cover your living expenses in Germany for the first three months of your stay, minimum of 2400,00 Euros (800 Euros for the first three months). Accepted evidence of funds are:
 Recent German or Irish bank statements for an account in your name for a minimum of three months (bank statements from other countries may be acceptable if the balance has been converted into EUR and the statements as such have been authenticated by the issuing bank with signature and stamp). OR blocked account holding minimum EUR 800/month for at least 3 months. OR formal obligation (Verpflichtungserklärung) by a sponsor resident in
Germany. Return Flight or additional funds of 1000,00 Euros
Argentinian citizens: police clearance certificate covering at least the last 3 years
Proof of housing in Germany for the initial time including full address (e.g., rental contract, hotel reservation or invitation letter of private accommodation with name, full address and their passport/ID copy)
Health insurance cover valid for the whole duration of the intended stay
Valid passport (signed by the holder, issued within the last 10 years and valid for at least 6 months after the intended stay in Germany with at least two consecutive blank pages)
1 copy of the passport, including all pages with entries
Current Irish visa/entry stamp or Irish residence permit (IRP) + 1 copy

Please note that the German Embassy Dublin reserves the right to ask for additional documents at any time during processing. Submission of the above-mentioned documents does not guarantee that a visa is granted.
